Re: Temporary Modification of Beach Curfew Hours

To Whom It May Concern:

The City of Newport Beach has granted the Surfrider Foundation and Pepperdine University permission to occupy the beaches after the posted hours according to 11.08.030 of the NBMC for their study of grunion runs. The grunion run monitoring will occur at two locations beginning at the Santa Ana River mouth to the Newport Pier and from the Newport Pier to the jetty.

The monitoring schedule will be as follows: Weds. April 7, 11:15 pm-1:15 am, Thurs. April 8, 11:55 pm-1:55 am, Weds. April 21, 10:40 pm-12:40 am, Thurs. April 22, 11:05 pm-1:05 am, Thurs. May 6, 10:50 pm-12:50 am, Fri. May 7, 11:40 pm-1:40 a., Thurs. May 20, 10:10 pm-12:10 am, Fri. May 21, 10:40 pm-12:40 am, Fri. June 4, 10:40 pm-12:40 am and Sat. June 5, 11:30 pm-1:30 am.

The below outlined conditions shall apply during the above approved dates and times. Failure to comply with these conditions may result in the immediate cancellation of permission.

- Volunteers will be required to carry a copy of this letter with them at all times while on the beach and present it upon request of law enforcement
- All beach ordinances will be strictly enforced (i.e.: noise, dogs and alcohol)
- No vehicles permitted on the beach at any time
- Volunteers will be responsible and respectful to area residents
- Volunteer and monitoring noise must be kept to a minimum at all times
