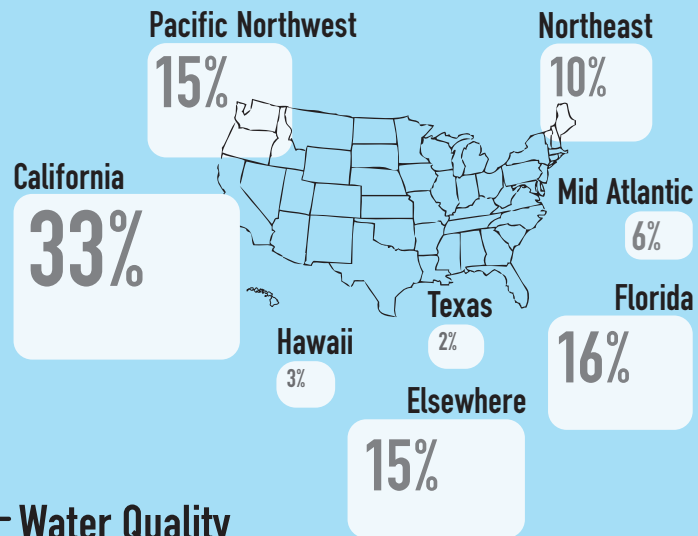


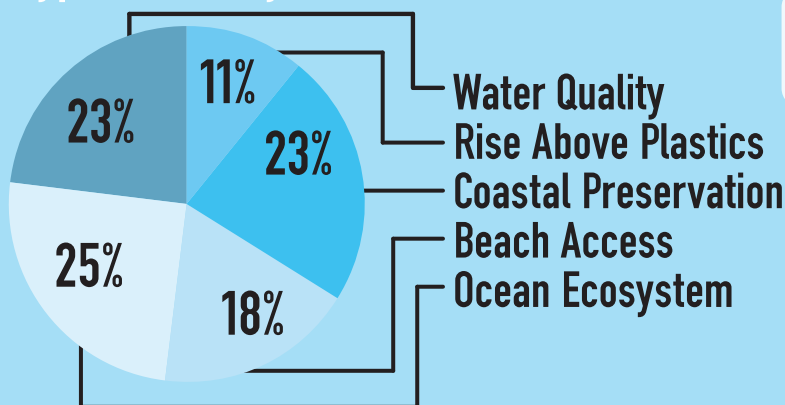

## Definition of a coastal victory

An environmental victory is a decision made in favor of the coastal and ocean environment that results in a positive conservation outcome, improves coastal access, or both.

## Seven notable wins

**Nye Creek Clean Up**  
Updated regulations, infrastructure improvements, and creek restoration to improve water quality at Nye Creek beach

**Chicago Surf Access**  
Legalized surfing at four Chicago beaches

**DC Single Use Bag Fee**  
Imposed 5-cent fee on single-use paper and plastic bags to support Anacostia River clean up

**Save Trestles**  
Stopped toll road that would destroy state park and damage surf

**Lake Worth Beach Fill**  
Stopped damaging beach fill project to protect reefs and surf

**Offshore Oil Drilling**  
Stopped new offshore oil drilling in continental US for next 7 years

**Reserva Marina Tres Palmas**  
Established marine reserve in Puerto Rico to protect coral reefs and surf
